SONNING GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- A ball shall be deemed "Out of Bounds" when played over the exterior boundaries of the course, which include both car parks, the patio area and the area to the right of the white posts on the 1st, 13th and 5th fairway. Rule 27-1 applies.
- A ball driven over the railway fence **MUST NOT** be fetched by either players or caddies.
- Water hazards are denoted by yellow posts. Rule 26-1a and b apply.
- Lateral water hazards are denoted by red posts. Rule 26-1c applies.
- All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: if the ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay, which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- Stones and rakes in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies. (Please leave rakes in bunkers after play).
- A ball coming to rest on wheel marks, providing these marks are on any 'closely mown area' may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty. Rule 25-1b(f) applies.
- Paths which are constructed from sleepers or which have been edged, either by timber or concrete edging, are Immovable Obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 24-2.b(i) (The relief ends where the edging ends). Other paths are integral parts of the course and no relief may be taken (Except under penalty).
- In any area of "Ground Under Repair" play is prohibited, the player shall not play his ball from, or take his stance in, such ground. Rule 25-1b applies.
- The black and white ball locating posts on the 1st, 10th and 12th fairways are movable obstructions and relief may be taken. Rule 24-1 applies.
- All mobile course watering equipment is classed as "Immovable Obstructions" and relief may be taken under Rule 24-2. Under no circumstances may equipment be moved.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Match Play - Loss of Hole;
Stroke Play - Two Strokes.
